O R D E R

After considering the parties' submissions and oral argument the court finds it appropriate to require additional briefing in the above captioned appeal.

Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- (1) On or before October 20, 2023, the appointed Amicus Curiae, Angela Oliver of Haynes and Boone, LLP (“Amicus”), and the Secretary of Health and Human Services (“Secretary”) shall each submit a supplemental brief, not to exceed 20 pages, addressing:
 - a. Whether parents may lawfully represent their minor child *pro se* in asserting a claim under the National Vaccine Injury Compensation Program, 42 U.S.C. § 300aa-10 *et seq.* (the “Vaccine Act”);
 - b. Whether, in this case, the Court of Federal Claims and the Special Master engaged in an equitable tolling analysis that was “based on a consideration of all relevant facts and circumstances,” *K.G. v. Sec’y of Health & Hum. Services*, 951 F.3d 1374, 1382 (Fed. Cir. 2020), including W.J.’s parents’ *pro se* status; and
 - c. Whether 28 U.S.C. § 2501, which provides “[a] petition on the claim of a person under legal disability . . . at the time the claim accrues may be filed within three years after the disability ceases,” applies to claims brought under the Vaccine Act.
- (2) On or before November 3, 2023, Amicus and the Secretary shall each submit a responsive brief, not to exceed 10 pages.
- (3) On the same dates set forth above, W.J., by his parents, may file briefs of the lengths given above and addressing the same questions listed in paragraph 1.
